STATE FUNDING FOR HAMDEN SCHOOLS & FAMILIES

The school grants will go toward the following work:

Bear Path: parking, lighting & energy improvements—\$105,000

Church Street: restroom renovations—\$60,000

High School: HVAC controls upgrade—\$175,000

High School: security camera upgrade—\$400,000

Middle School: energy efficiency water system upgrade—\$150,000

Helen Street: boiler replacement—\$250,000


Helen Street: replace classroom carpeting—\$200,000

Ridge Hill: replace obsolete drinking fountains—\$150,000

Spring Glen: install safety padding in gymnasium—\$25,000

Also, with state help, the **Hamden Housing Authority** will finance a number of rehabilitation projects at the **60-unit Hamden Village** and the adjacent **50-unit Hamden Village Extension**.

And, Hamden's nonprofit **P.L.A.C.E.** (photo on left) was also awarded a grant to help with its project of creating a **children's museum and art center**.
