# Legislative Update from your State Senator Ted Kennedy, Jr.

## **Pesticides Use and Schools**

Lawn care pesticides contain toxic ingredients that have been linked to cancer, neurological disorders, immune system dysfunction and other health problems.

Under my leadership, the Environment Committee unanimously passed a bill that would mandate that boards of education provide notice 72 hours in advance of the application of pesticides on school grounds. The bill received bipartisan support, and I am looking forward to getting this legislation passed by the full General Assembly.

## **Transparency in Health Care Costs**

This session, I was proud to support a bill that would provide greater transparency to consumers regarding the cost of health care.

The bill would create a public database of the most common medical procedures and the amount paid by insurers for those procedures. The more information consumers have, the better they are able to make informed decisions about their health care.
