## **Support for Bridgeport Families, Schools and Taxpayers**

### **Funding for Education**

- **\$181 million in funding** for Bridgeport's public school budget
- **\$2.1 million for local adult education**

### **Car Tax Cuts**

- Car taxes will be capped at 37 mills which means a **12% tax cut for Bridgeport**
- On your July car tax bill **you will save \$52** if your car is assessed at \$10,000
- On your July car tax bill **you will save \$104** if your car is assessed at \$20,000

### **Funding for Bridgeport**

- Over **\$32 million in total** in non-education aid to the city
- **\$6.9 million more in total funding than last year** from the state
- Includes \$1.4 million for local **road and bridge repairs**
